DATA PROTECTION POLICY

Personal data from all club members is collected and held by the club for its legitimate interests so that all members can be uniquely identified.

Such data involves name, postal address, email address, telephone numbers (landline and mobile) and photographic distinctions.

In the course of its activity, the club will handle photographic images from members and record entries to events and the corresponding results.

The club will also retain historical records containing specific member data, such as in programmes and catalogues. This will include details of award winners.

When competing in external competitive events the club will submit to the organisers of such events whatever personal information is requested of the members whose images have been selected to represent the club. This is likely to comprise names and photographic distinctions.

Contact details of all club members will be restricted to the club committee.

Membership contact information will NOT be made available for electronic marketing.

The club will regularly review and document compliance with this policy.

As required under the Data Protection Act 2018, which incorporates the European Union General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and replaces the current legislation (the Data Protection Act 1998).
